

Area of learning	What we will be learning
	<p>Next week will be our last chance to catch up in all subjects and to complete all of our units.</p> <p>By now, all classes have completed their diaries detailing the Great Fire of London and decorated the covers to make them look old.</p> <p>Towards the end of the week, most lessons will be dedicated to rehearsing for our Great Fire of London performances that we will display for the parents. The children have had a large part in creating the play-scripts and knowing what needs to be included. They have learned some of their songs during music sessions and I'm sure it will all come together beautifully.</p>
	<p>Some classes will attend the fire station trip on Sunday and Monday and learn a little more about how fires are put out in the modern day. Meanwhile, their peers will be back in school creating wonderful triptychs in art. A triptych is a piece of art created in 3 pieces and later joined together.</p>
	<p>Teachers will finish off the multiplication unit with a few word problems next week, helping the children to apply the methods they've learned.</p> <p>Amidst all of this, children will enjoy watching the Nursery and Reception concerts, as well as, practising their own assemblies for English and Arabic.</p>
